

# **Baltic Open Tournament - GC Croquet September 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> 2019, LATVIA**

### **Programme of the tournament:**

# Friday, September 6th

- · From 15:00 Arrival of the players to Sigulda Croquet Club (Sigulda), lawn available for practice.
- · 18:00 Players briefing in Sigulda, followed by opening ceremony with snacks buffet and welcome drinks.
- · Beverages (water, tea, coffee, soft drinks) included in the entry fee
- · Buffet and welcome drinks included in the catering package

#### Saturday, September 7th

- around 8:00 8 players (blocks C and D) departure from hotel to Ogre Croquet Club (Ogre). Information about logistics will be provided.
- 9:00 Blocks A and B start play in Sigulda, Blocks C and D start play in Ogre
- · Beverages (water, tea, coffee, soft drinks) included in the entry fee
- · Lunch will be served in the clubhouse included in the catering package
- · Block results are announced. Eventual play-offs.
- · Quarterfinals of main event are played.
- Depending on the hour, snacks may be ordered to be served in the clubhouse included in the catering package around 19:00 transfer from Ogre back to Sigulda
- From 20:00-21:00 dinner option at the hotel in Sigulda. After 21:00 only drinks will be served to be paid individually by the players

### Sunday, September 8th

- around 8:00 plate players depart to Ogre. Information about logistics will be provided.
- 9:00 plate games start in Ogre
- 10:00 top 8 players meet in Sigulda for Semifinals, Finals and Shield
- · Beverages (water, tea, coffee, soft drinks) included in the entry fee
- · Lunch will be served in the clubhouse included in the catering package
- around 16:00 transfer from Ogre to Sigulda
- around 17:00 awards ceremony in Sigulda, followed by a cocktail reception with fingerfood included in the catering package
- · opportunity to play some friendly games
- departure

# **Tournament Regulations**

- 1. WCF GC Rules 5<sup>th</sup> Edition will be applied.
- 2. WCF Sports Regulations are applied in all situations not described in detail here.
- 3. Double banking games on two lawns.
- 4. Dawson balls
- 5. 13 or 19 hoop games
- 6. Number of players -16
- 7. Tournament Manager Roberts Stafeckis
- 8. Tournament Referee –Viktors Harlinskis (Southwick Croquet Academy certificate), Assistant Referees Andreis Savinovs and Roberts Stafeckis.
- 9. Four blocks, players divided in blocks according WCF GC rankings as of 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019.
- 10. No time limits unless severe weather conditions occur.
- 11. Block play
  - a. Each player meets each in on 19 hoop game.
  - b. Places in the blocks are determined as follows:
    - Number of wins
    - Net points in all 3 games (except 11.c.)
    - Net points between the tied players
  - c. In case the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places have the same number of wins, a single 13 hoop game play-off will be played.
  - d. 1st and 2nd from each block qualify to the knock-out stage.
  - e. 3rd and 4th from each block play for the plate.

#### 12. Plate knock-out

- a. Single 13 hoop games
- b. Knock out pairs formed according to players places in blocks. Block A playing Block B, and Block C playing Block D.
- c. The plate final single 19 hoop game.

#### 13. Knock-out stage

- a. Matches best of 3 games (13 hoops).
- b. Knock out pairs formed according to players places in blocks. Block A playing Block B, and Block C playing Block D.
- c. ½ final matches:
  - Winners qualify for semi-finals.
  - Losers play single game knock-out for 5-8 places.
- d. Semifinals and final matches.
  - Semifinal winners playing final match,
  - Semifinal losers playing bronze final match.
